2020 - Covid season, 56 players/4 teams/25-26 games


2021 - ~85 players/6 teams/32-33 games

WSSL 2022 Rule Changes

- Rules Committee asked to address:
 - Game cut-off time
 - Heat Index policy
 - League bat policy
 - Establishing required pitching distance
 - Rules Committee: Larry Rouse (Chair), Jim Wilson, Ed Connors, Bill Wagner and John Ray

WSSL By-Law Proposals for Vote

Issue: Membership vote required to establish, change, remove or modify WSSL By-Laws

Article III - Elections, Section 2 - Term of Office: No Board of Directors member may serve more than two consecutive terms in the same position. Once a change of position or a break in service, defined as a full two-year term, is realized, the board member may again be elected for a new term.

WSSL By-Law Proposals for Vote (con't)

(Create) **Article X - Fiscal Policy** regarding our agreed upon spending limits: A member of the Board of Directors, or their designee, may have costs, such as supplies, equipment, fees, etc. to accomplish an assigned task. Therefore, any board member is authorized to spend, and receive reimbursement from the league, up to \$100, without prior approval from the Board of Directors.

WSSL By-Law Proposals for Vote (con't)

Article II - Board of Directors' Job Descriptions, Section 7 - Communications Director - The communications director serves the marketing, media, and public relations interests of the WSSL, utilizing their skills to uphold the league brand's positive image. This director is the board member responsible for all aspects of communication, marketing and publicity for the league. They make sure the organization maintains a positive public image and that all materials viewed by current and prospective members follow the brand's specific messaging guidelines. Along with the WSSL Commissioner, the Communications Director serves as the face of the league at any media event.
