#### Volunteers Are Vital

- WSSL relies on a cadre of volunteers to make the league work.
- Many important jobs:
  - Umpires
  - Scorekeepers
  - Scheduler for umpires, scorekeepers and substitutes
  - Field setup and shutdown
  - Committee work
- 2022 saw an increase in volunteer participation.
- We thank you for your contributions!
- We encourage others to step up in 2023.

- November league (NL) was all about learning
  - What did it feel like to just play with a bunch of old geezers?
  - What did it feel like to play a different position?
  - What was it like to have everyone play a minimum of 5 innings?
  - Kiwanis vs Quarterpath?
  - Short fielder vs no short fielder?
- Informal and formal feedback suggests the NL was a smashing success!
  - 13 players hit 23 home runs including one walk off 3 run shot and one walk off grand slam, led by Ed Ewell's 4 taters!
  - Average runs per game in November was 14.7 vs 12.4 during regular season
  - Many comments about the more relaxed and supportive "feel" playing in the NL

- On to April! But there are a lot of questions to be answered
  - Where will Jamestown Division play their games?
  - Will there be specific rules for each division, and if yes, what are they?
  - Will there be an age cutoff between the two divisions?
  - Will players have any choice in which division they play?
  - How many teams in each division?
  - How many players on each team in each division?
  - And the REALLY big question . . . Will we even have two divisions in 2023?

- On to April! But there are a lot of questions to be answered
  - Where will Jamestown Division play their games?
    - Kiwanis vs Quarterpath (QP)
    - Clearly, there are differing opinions as gleaned from informal discussions
    - Many want to ensure we stay connected to players in Yorktown Division by playing at QP on the same days
    - Many want to play at Kiwanis because they like both the opportunity to hit out-of-thepark HRs, and that the fence restricts how far the ball can roll
    - There are some logistical issues that need to be considered like maximizing the number of umps and scorekeepers we have, storage of equipment, etc.
    - We will also survey those who were eligible to play in the November league to hear the views from a larger population of probable impacted players


- On to April! But there are a lot of questions to be answered
  - Will there be specific rules for each division, and if yes, what are they?
    - For the Jamestown Division, we made some changes for the November league to a few
      of our rules based on the responses to a pre-season survey these included use of the
      short fielder, minimum innings, courtesy/substitute runner, and how to handle multiple
      HR's
      - We learned a lot in November and will be re-surveying the players
    - For the Yorktown Division, there has also been some informal discussion about both whether to use the short fielder and whether to move the distance between bases to 70 feet Andy will be investigating both of these, plus any others which may come up

- On to April! But there are a lot of questions to be answered
  - Will there be an age cutoff between the two divisions?
  - Will players have any choice in which division they play?
    - There will be a "soft" cutoff such that players younger than whatever the age is will not be able to choose to play in the Jamestown Division\*
    - Both divisions will have a draft with the Yorktown Division going first
    - Players older than the soft cutoff age can declare for the Yorktown Division draft
      - We do not anticipate **telling** players they cannot declare for the Yorktown Division draft
    - Players not drafted by a Yorktown Division team will automatically be placed in the Jamestown Division draft

- On to April! But there are a lot of questions to be answered
  - How many teams in each division?
  - How many players on each team in each division?
  - And the REALLY big question . . . Will we even have two divisions in 2023?
    - Last question first we really believe we will have two, 4-team divisions in 2023
    - BUT . . . it is a numbers game

- In 2022, we brought in 46 new players, but also lost 30 players
- Our recruiting committee (Bud, Marcia, and Ric) organized a number of promotional/recruiting activities during the year which both helped get visibility on the league into the community and led to attracting a number of individuals into the league
- However, the best recruiting engine we have is YOU!
- Think about people you know, especially in the ~50-60 year old range and reach out to them
- Lots of information on our website to help you sell the league
- If half the current players brought in one person each, we would easily have enough for 4 more teams!

- Next Steps
  - 1st step elect division presidents (today)
  - Andy and I both want to quickly identify at least 4 managers for each division which would operate as a Management Council (MC) with their respective president

  - Jamestown MC will create the survey regarding play location, rules, etc. to be sent to those who were eligible for the November league
    - These results will be used to finalize decisions on these areas early January
  - Finally, our goal is to have answers to all your questions by March 1
