## Scheduling Approach

The spring season will be conducted with 3 teams of 10-12 players. During each segment of 3 consecutive playing dates, each team will play 2 double-headers and have an "off" day. Players of the off-team will serve as "fill-ins" to supplement the scheduled teams. Using this approach, each team's season will consist of 24 games spread over 18 playing dates (4 games for every 3 dates).

Example: On April 16 (opening day), Red and Silver play a double-header against each other. Blue players will serve as fill-ins during these games. They will be divided into two groups and assigned as needed to the Red and Silver teams.

This approach gives all players a chance to play on every date. Off-team players are strongly encouraged to attend on their off days. Doing so ensures that the scheduled teams will have enough players to field a full team, especially when they have several absences.
